You've vilified the CIC, who effectively run the site on behalf of the PC, and who, with the help of the Conservation Society, and a small army of very willing volunteers have already successfully given us the permissive footpath, planted an orchard and wild flower beds, and set up the pop-up pub events, in addition to the considerable repair and maintenance work required.

You also infer that there is something unsavoury and sinister about the Northiam Bonfire Society, and by association, it's members. Referring to it being 'an extremely powerful and influential group within the village', although you fail to mention the generous donations it makes to community causes and organisations.
